1. This is a writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking the following prayers:-

“a. Issue writ of mandamus and/or any other appropriate writ in order against the respondents directing them to allow the petitioner to participate in Counselling scheduled to be held since 2nd June, 2025;

b. Pass an Order for an independent inquiry against the Respondent No. 2 in light of the present case;

c. Issue Writ of Mandamus and/or any other appropriate Writ in order against respondent no. 2 directing to release the actual results of the petitioner of both the Sessions based on his correct and original response sheets and allow the



same to be considered as the final result for the purpose of admissions into any educational institutions;

d. Pass an Order directing Respondent no. 2 to produce original and true response sheets of the petitioner of both Sessions before the Hon'ble Court....”

2. Since the said counselling is already over and finalised, the petition has become infructuous. Presumably for this reasons, nobody has been appearing for the petitioner.
3. Accordingly, the petition is dismissed as infructuous.
