1. The present petition has been filed under Sections 29A(4) and 29A(5) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996¹ seeking extension of the mandate of the learned Sole Arbitrator.

2. It is to be noted that the learned Sole Arbitrator was appointed by this Court *vide* order dated 22.10.2021. However, the arbitral record, including the pleadings, remained with the erstwhile arbitrator and was made available to the present learned Sole Arbitrator only in August 2023.

3. It is further submitted that both parties have led their evidence, the Respondent has concluded its final arguments and only rejoinder submissions by the Petitioner is remaining.
