1. This is a writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking the following prayer(s):-

“It is therefore, prayed that this Hon'ble Court may kindly be pleased to issue writ of mandamus to the Respondent No.1 to 3 to dismantle the unauthorized construction of the godown and further to release the public land measuring about 1200 sq. yards forming part of Khasra No.30/9 in the revenue estate of Village Nangli Poona, Delhi- 110036 in the interest of justice. ...”

2. For the reasons stated in the petition, issue notice.
3. Mr. Gupta, learned counsel accepts notice on behalf of respondent



No. 1, Ms. Farah, learned ASC accepts notice on behalf of respondent No. 2 and Mr. Anubhav, learned counsel accepts notice on behalf of respondent No. 3.

4. A perusal of the petition shows that the petitioners are residents of Village Budhpur, Delhi- 110036, and are seeking to agitate issues with regard to unauthorised construction of godown forming part of Village Nangli Poona, Delhi- 110036, which is at a distance of about 5 kms from where the petitioners reside.
5. I am of the view that no rights of the petitioners are affected and the present petition is not a Public Interest Litigation. The petition on the face of it seems to be for motivated and extraneous purposes. For the said reasons, I am not inclined to exercise jurisdiction under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.
6. The present petition is dismissed in the aforesaid terms.
