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**I.A. 13446/2026 (Seeking withdrawal of the petition by petitioner)**

1. The present Application has been filed under Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, seeking withdrawal of the present Petition, being O.M.P. (COMM) 18/2024, in view of the disputes between the parties having been amicably settled under the Vivad Se Vishwas-III Scheme.

2. The Applicant/Petitioner also seeks appropriate directions to the Registry of this Court for the release of the amount deposited, pursuant to the Order dated 09.01.2025, along with up-to-date interest, *vide* Demand Draft No. 226733 dated 13.02.2024, in favour of the learned Registrar General of this Court.
