1. By way of the present application, the applicant seeks regular bail in connection with FIR No. 283/2018 dated 11.05.2018, registered at Police Station Mehrauli, District South Delhi, under Sections 363/342/376/506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, and Section 6 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012.
2. After some arguments, Mr. Mukesh Kalia, learned counsel for the applicant, seeks permission to withdraw the present bail application. However, he seeks a direction to the Trial Court to expedite the trial.
3. Having regard to the fact that the applicant has already been in custody for over four years, the applicant is permitted to make such a



request before the learned Trial Court, which is requested to consider the same in accordance with its own Board and having regard to the age of the matters pending before it.

4. Ms. Manjeet Arya, learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State, and Mr. Sarthak Karol, learned Legal Aid Counsel appearing on behalf of the prosecutrix, assure the Court that no unnecessary adjournments shall be sought before the Trial Court.

5. The bail application is disposed of with these observations.
