1. The petitioner in the instant petition is seeking direction to Respondent Nos. 2 to 4 to issue a duplicate SIM in the petitioner's correct name, as the Customer Application Form (CAF) erroneously recorded the name as "N.K. Sharma" instead of "Narender Kumar Sharma,"
2. During the course of submissions, it is seen that the only reason assigned by the petitioner not to approach the concerned Consumer Court is that the said authority will take a considerable amount of time to grant the petitioner the relief sought herein. The same cannot be the reason to entertain the instant petition.
3. The relief sought herein falls outside the jurisdiction of the writ Court,



exercising powers under Article 226 of the Constitution of India. In view thereof, the instant petition is dismissed. Pending application also stands disposed of. All rights and contentions of the parties are left open.
