1. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the parties submit that the *inter se* disputes between the parties have been amicably settled under the aegis of Delhi High Court Mediation and Conciliation Center.

6. Suit is decreed and disposed of in terms thereof along with all the pending applications.

7. Court fees to the extent of 75 per cent be refunded to the plaintiff upon completion of all formalities as per rules.
