1. The present petition has been filed under Section 439(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (corresponding to Section 483(3) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023), seeking cancellation of bail granted to respondent No. 1 by the learned Sessions Court *vide* order dated 29.08.2025, in connection with FIR No. 372/2025 dated 06.08.2025, registered at Police Station Jamia Nagar, South East Delhi, under Sections 69 and 79 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

2. After some arguments, Ms. Rupali Panwar, learned counsel for the petitioner, does not press the present petition at this stage, without prejudice to the petitioner's right to avail appropriate remedies in accordance with law, including approaching the concerned Station House



Officer and the learned Sessions Court for cancellation of bail in the event of any supervening circumstances, such as threats to the petitioner.

3. The present petition is accordingly dismissed as withdrawn, in terms of the above submission.

4. It is clarified that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the case, and all rights and contentions of the parties, including respondent No. 1, in any future proceedings are left open.
