1. This hearing has been done through hybrid mode.
2. The Petitioner has filed the present petition seeking compensation regarding *Khasra* No.253 (1-19) also written as 255/2, 256(0-4) and 268(3-12), which is stated to be acquired *vide* Award No.2 of the year 1991.
3. *Vide* order dated 6th October, 2025, the Petitioner was directed to place on record the copy of the award, which is the basis for seeking the compensation. Moreover, even the order dated 23rd December, 2025 records that the same has not been placed on record.
