ORDER

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1. This suit is instituted on behalf of the Plaintiffs seeking a decree for permanent injunction restraining the Defendant, its proprietor or partners, servants, agents, affiliates, associates stockiest from manufacturing, trading, supplying, selling, marketing, in any manner including online sale or dealing in any other way, any goods and/or any other products including two wheeler spare parts along with packaging materials under the Plaintiff No. 1's HERO trademarks including the device marks or any other mark/logo/ labels which are identical and similar to the Plaintiff No. 1's HERO trademarks and/or device marks, amounting to infringement of Plaintiff No. 1's registered trademarks, amongst other reliefs.

2. During the pendency of the suit parties were referred for mediation before the Delhi High Court Mediation and Conciliation Centre, where they have amicably settled their *inter se* disputes and executed a Settlement



Agreement dated 25.03.2026 incorporating the terms of settlement, copy of which has been placed on record.

3. Court has perused the terms of the settlement and finds the same to be lawful. Accordingly, the suit is decreed in terms of the settlement between the parties.
4. Registry is directed to draw up the decree sheet.
5. Suit stands disposed of along with pending application.
6. Plaintiffs are held entitled to refund of entire court fees in accordance with the Court Fees Act, 1870.
