“It is, therefore most respectfully prayed that this Hon'ble Court may graciously be pleased to: -

“(a) pass an appropriate judgment and decree and/or order thereby setting aside/reversing/modifying/varying the judgment and decree dated 20.02.2010 passed by the court of Sh. Nikhil Chopra, Addl. District Judge, Delhi, in Civil Suit No. 186/2008 - 14/2006 entitled M/s Pragati Papers Industries Ltd. versus M/s Espee Trading Corporation & another;
