ORDER

At the outset, Mr. Kshitiz Garg, learned counsel appearing for Mr. Amol Sinha, learned Additional Standing Counsel (Criminal) for the State informs the court that instead of being granted parole, to which the petitioner was not entitled, *vide* order dated 07.11.2025, the jail authorities have granted to him the 1st spell of furlough for 03 weeks subject to certain conditions.

On being queried, Mr. Garg explains that though the 1st spell of furlough was granted *vide* order dated 07.11.2025, the petitioner was unable to avail it since he was unable comply with the conditions. Subsequently however, the conditions were modified *vide* order dated 10.12.2025,



dispensing with the requirement of surety and accepting from the petitioner only a personal bond for Rs. 10,000/-.

The status report dated 10.01.2026 *inter-alia* enclosing copies of orders dated 07.11.2025 and 10.12.2025 has been handed-up in court. The same is taken on record.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed-of as satisfied.

Pending applications, if any, stand disposed-of.
