1. *Mr. Brijesh Kumar Tamber*, CGSC, appearing for respondent nos.1 & 2, Ministry of Corporate Affairs (**'MCA'**) and Registrar of Companies (**'ROC'**), has presented a counter affidavit with E-filing No.66026/2026 dated 7th February 2026, since the same was not on record.
2. It is stated in the counter affidavit that an inspection was ordered against *M/s Explorers Travels and Tours Pvt. Ltd.* under Section 206(5) of the Companies Act, 2013 *vide* MCA's communication dated 23rd September 2024.

Office of Director General of Corporate Affairs (**'DGCoA'**) on 5th December 2025 for taking necessary steps.
