ORDER

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1. During course of arguments, it was apprised that the next date of hearing before the learned Trial Court is 27.03.2026, for recording of evidence of the mother of the deceased.
2. The charges have been ascertained very recently and after hearing arguments for some time, learned counsel for the applicant, without prejudice to his rights and contentions, submits that he would not press the present application at this stage, however, he may be permitted to file the application afresh once the evidence of the mother of the deceased is recorded.
3. Even the prosecution has no objection to the abovesaid request.
4. Learned Addl. P.P. for the State submits that they would ensure the presence of mother of the deceased before the learned Trial Court on said date.



5. In view of the above, the present application is disposed of as not pressed. Liberty, as prayed, is granted.
6. Moreover, if for any reason, whatsoever, the mother of deceased does not make herself available before the learned Trial Court for recording of her evidence, the applicant herein would become entitled, in that scenario also, to file fresh bail application.
7. The petition stands disposed of as not pressed.
