1. The petition is for the following relief:

"i) Direct the Respondent No. 1 to decide/dispose of Case No. 763/2024, titled "Vidya Saini vs. Manoj Saini & Anr." filed by the Petitioner under Rule 22(3)(1) of the DMWPSC Rules 2016 and Delhi Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Sr. Citizen Act, 2007 whereby praying for eviction of the Respondent No.2 and 3 and their children from her Property bearing Flat No.B-5, Second Floor, 1443, Wazir Nagar, Kotla Mubarak Pur, New Delhi and Property No.D-48, Sector-6, Naida, Distt. G.B. Nagar, U.P.;

ii) Direct the Respondent No.4 to ensure the protection of the life and property of the Petitioner in accordance with Rules, 2016 and Senior Citizen Act. "
