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1. Learned counsel for the petitioner, on his prayer, was granted leave of the Court to amend the petition *vide* order dated 24.12.2025, however, instead of moving any application seeking requisite amendment in the petition, he has altogether filed an amended petition. As a result of filing of the amended petition, it is difficult to continue with the proceedings of this matter with two similar petitions on record containing pleadings and documents in duplicate.

2. In view of the above, we are of the opinion that it would be more



appropriate if the petitioner withdraws this writ petition and files a fresh petition.

3. Accordingly, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh petition.
