By virtue of the present petitions under *Section 528* of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (***BNSS***), the petitioners seek setting aside of the order dated 04.03.2025, passed by the learned CJM, Dwarka Court, Delhi in CC No.541/2024 entitled ***Madhu Verma Vs.
