1. This is an application filed under Section 151 of CPC, 1908 seeking the following prayers:-

*“a) Revive the present writ petition in terms of liberty granted vide order dated 13.02.2026;*

*b) Pass appropriate directions against the respondents for immediate compliance of order dated 13.02.2026 and initiate appropriate proceedings for non-compliance of order passed by the Hon’ble Court; . . .”*



2. Mr. Pandey, learned counsel at the outset states that he had appeared on 13.02.2026 and inadvertently his appearance had not been marked.
