**ORDER
16.04.2026**

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1. The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following reliefs:-

- (a) issue a writ in the nature of Certiorari or any other writ, order or direction to the Respondents setting aside and quashing of all orders/ decisions of the revocation of the Health Licenses including the letter dated 25.07.2017 and declaring the said revocation as *void ab initio* and *non est*;



- (b) Issue appropriate writ, order or direction quashing the two Rejection Letters dated 20.01.2021 *inter-alia* rejecting the intimation of automatic extension of the applications filed by the Petitioners on 09.07.202;
- (c) Issue appropriate writ, order or direction quashing the Rejection Letters dated 20.01.2021 *inter-alia* rejecting the applications for renewal of the Health Licenses, Lodging House License, DG Set License and Laundry License for commencing period 01.04.2021;
- (d) Issue appropriate writ, order or direction including a writ of prohibition, prohibiting the Respondents from taking any action of any nature whatsoever based on the Rejection Letters dated 20.01.2021 both in relation to automatic extension of licences and renewal thereof, as well as basis the Show Cause Notice dated 01.03.2021;
- (e) Issue a Writ in the nature of Mandamus or any other writ, order or direction, to the Respondents directing the Respondents to renew the Health Licenses, Lodging House Licenses, Laundry Licenses and DG Sets Licenses in terms of the Applications dated 17.01.2020, 20.01.2020 and 30.03.2020 filed by the Petitioners;



2. In terms of the Office Order of the respondent-NDMC dated 23rd February, 2026, no separate license is required to be taken by the petitioner from NDMC in respect of the aforesaid activities if it holds a valid FSSAI and GST Registration, as applicable.
3. Copy of the Office Order dated 23rd February, 2026 has been handed over in Court and is taken on record.
4. In the present case, it is not disputed that the petitioner has a valid FSSAI License as well as GST Registration.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of holding that the petitioner does not require separate license(s) which are the subject matter of the writ petition.
6. All rights and contentions of the parties in any other proceedings shall remain open.
7. Pending application also stands disposed of.
