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1. The present case has been listed before this Court in view of the Order dated 09.12.2025 passed by the Ld. Joint Registrar. The Order dated 09.12.2025 reads as under:

“Test.Cas. 65/2017

1. Matter is at the stage of Petitioner's Evidence.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a suit for partition bearing CSDJ/206311/2016 titled Indu Jain v. Anjali Aggarwal and Ors. qua the suit property is pending before the District Court and the main contesting parties in the present petition have agreed for partition of the suit property with share of 1/3rd each.
